This competition offers pupils an opportunity not only to explore the theme of spring, but also to reflect on the cultural significance of renewal, hope, and new beginnings.



Pupils are invited to express what spring means to them through either an original poem or a short story. They may draw inspiration from nature, personal experiences, family traditions, or the diverse cultural stories that shape how spring is celebrated around the world. We particularly welcome pieces that highlight the richness of cultural identity and the ways in which different communities mark this season of renewal. **Entries will be judged on creativity, clarity of expression, and the ability to convey a meaningful sense of spring and its cultural resonance.**



As an added celebration of young voices, the best entries will be published in Nowruz Aberdeen 2026 - a digital book showcasing the creativity of students from all secondary schools in the city. **In addition, prize-winning pupils, their parents and the school headteacher will be invited to a civic celebration at the Town House, hosted by the Lord Provost on 20th March 2026**, where their achievements will be recognised as part of the wider Nowruz festivities.



We hope this opportunity will inspire young people to engage with both the spirit of Nowruz and the power of creative writing. Further details on submission guidelines, deadlines, and judging criteria are attached.
